Qualifications:

- High school diploma, GED, or equivalent combination of training & experience
- Possession of or ability to readily obtain a valid driver's license issued by the State of Georgia for the type of vehicle or equipment operated
- Possession of or ability to readily obtain a flagging certification
- Ability to obtain special licenses or certifications that may be required for the job

Skills:

- Language: Ability to read & understand documents such as City of Monroe safety policies & procedures, operation & maintenance instructions & procedure manuals
- Communication: Ability to effectively communicate with coworkers and citizens, follow oral instructions
- Physical: Ability to operate assigned equipment (mower, weed trimmer, hedge trimmer, chainsaw, blower, etc.), lift 50-100 lbs., withstand long periods of standing, tolerate extreme weather conditions

- Assists in overall maintenance of equipment
