Starting salary is dependent upon applicant's qualifications.

Qualified applicants must have:

- High school diploma or GED
- Current Georgia Firefighting Certificate of Compliance
- Georgia First Responder Certification to be obtained within first 12 months of hire date
- NIMS 100, 200, 700, 800
- Valid Class C Driver's License or better

Duties/Skills to perform in this position successfully, include:

- Certified by Georgia Firefighters Standards and Training Council
- Per Georgia Firefighter Standards & Training Council – and/or O.C.G.A. 25-4-8, Qualifications are as follows:
 - Must be at least 18 years of age
 - Not have been convicted of a felony in any jurisdiction within 10 years prior to employment/appointment
 - Good moral character as determined by investigation under procedure approved by the council
 - Be fingerprinted and a search made of local, state, and national fingerprint files to disclose any criminal record
 - Be in good physical condition as determined by a medical examination and successfully pass the minimum physical agility requirements as established by the council
 - Possess or achieve within 12 months after employment a high school diploma or GED
 - Complete the Georgia Basic Firefighter Training Course approved by Council and verified by successful completion of the State Firefighter Certification Test
